CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All applications must be made on the approved Form, obtainable from the Organisers. The supply of a Form does not constitute the offer of a space.
2. The Form must be completed with all relevant details by the Exhibitor or his Agent and sent to the address shown with payment. No space can be reserved unless a Form and payment have been received. The submission of a Form constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
3. All cheques should be payable to Shropshire Union Canal Society. Payments are NOT refundable.
4. No Exhibitor or Agent will be allowed on site until full payment has been received.
5. The Organisers reserve the right to re-let any space where full payment has not been made.
6. The Organisers have the right of lien on any goods on the site.
7. Space will be allocated at the sole discretion of the Organisers, who reserve the right to make alterations in the location at any time prior to or during the event.
8. The Exhibitor may make written requests about the location of the Space or the identity of neighbouring Exhibitors but the Organiser cannot guarantee to comply with these and the application cannot be conditional on these.
9. The Organisers have the right to refuse space without giving a reason; in this case any money paid will be refunded.
10. The Exhibitors and their contractors must comply with the current HEALTH AND SAFETY LEGISLATION.
11. All Exhibitors and contractors must have PUBLIC LIABILITY INDEMNITY of at least £5,000,000 unless otherwise agreed, in writing, with the Organisers.
12. Each Exhibitor and contractor will undertake a RISK ASSESSMENT which must be brought to the event.
13. The Organisers will give the Exhibitor access to the Space for a reasonable period before and after the event to erect or remove their Exhibit. If the Exhibit is not set-up 30 minutes before the public are admitted the Organisers may remove it at the Exhibitors expense.
14. All vehicles must be removed to the approved car-park prior to the event opening. Any offending vehicle will be removed by the Organisers at the Exhibitors expense.
15. Vehicles will not be permitted on site when the public are present.
16. Exhibitors will comply with any rules or regulations made by the Organisers regarding the conduct of the Event. Display of such rules or regulations at Canal Central will constitute sufficient notice.
17. Exhibitors will comply with the requirements of the FIRE BRIGADE, ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH OFFICER and any other competent authority, as well as any statutes, regulations or bye-laws relating to the site or its use.
18. Exhibitors will be responsible for the conduct of their staff and their contractors.
